The College shall maintain an Emergency Response Plan that is National Incident Management System (NIMS) compliant in accordance with the Campus Security Enhancement Act of 2008, as revised.

The authority to declare a campus state of emergency and declare an end to a state of emergency rests with the College President or his/her designee.

In the event of an emergncy, as defined in the Emergency Response Plan, the Campus Deptatement shallimmediately place the appropriate procedures necessaryneet an emergency, safeguard persons and property, and maintain educational facilities. After the tall response, and depending upon the nature and magnitude of the event, an incidenommander outside the Campus Police partment may lead the actions taken by the College. The incident commander, command staff, and general staff responding as identified in the Emergency Response Plan, have delegated authority to act as necessary to stabilize the incident. The dident Commander will consult with the resident as soon as possible regarding the emergency and the establishment of a campus state of emergency.

During the first twentyfour (24) hours of the incidentand after declaring a campus state of emergency, Board Policy 7154 Purchasing is suspended to allow for a quick responsemainable injury, loss of life, and damage to propertySuspension of this policy applies by to those assigned responsibility the College's Emergency Response Plan and for the execution of such.

During a state of emergency, only those persons authorized by the incident commander will be allowed on the campus. Those who cannot present proper identification and/onareuthorized to be present are subject to arrest

The Emergency Response Plan, including the persons identified to fulfill various emergency responsibilities in the plan, shalled approved by the Business Services Advisory mittee.
